Three experiments were performed to test traditional PCA with a combined PCA for DT (Delaunay Triangulation). In each test, a different amount of training and image testing is used. Results can be continuously improved if appropriate landmarks are used in combination as seen in the above results.

Paper 3: Since PCA works better than LDA when the number of samples in each class is small and the size of the face image is large. However, LDA performance is better when the database is very large and has separate phase databases. To benefit both of these approaches, PCA is integrated. This paper introduces a new face recognition system, a PCA reduction process followed by the LDA and a division by City Block Distance Calculation. Recognition values are compared with various PCA features and LDA features. It can be concluded that when the number of face images for each subject is smaller the PCA is better, but for larger training face images and different training data, its combination with LDA shows better results than pure PCA.

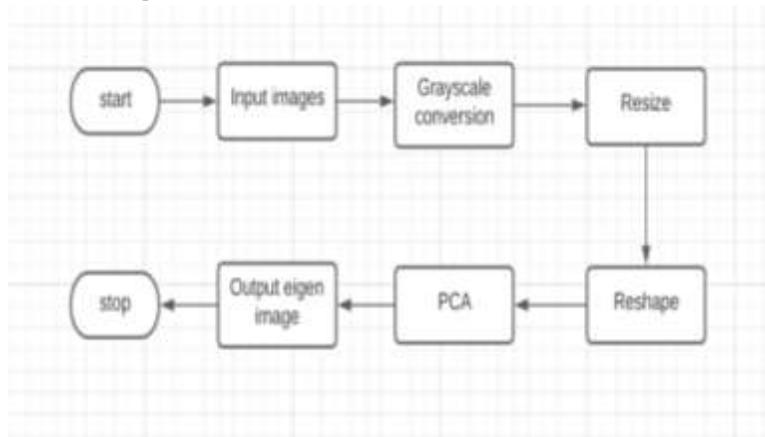

III. IMPLEMENTATION

ENVIRONMENTAL SETUP:

To develop this project, we have used Python programming language. Anaconda Navigator (Spyder) has been used as a tool to get a specific image effect, the distribution includes science-compatible packages for Windows, Linux, and MacOS. Anaconda Navigator is a desktop user interface (GUI) embedded in Anaconda® distribution that allows you to launch applications and easily manage conda packages, locations, and channels without using command line commands.

- After successful installation, open a new python file.
- Import necessary packages like cv2, NumPy.
- Upload the data set path in the python file and run.
- Resultant output of eigen face will be saved in the same path as the python file.

IMPLEMENTATION STEPS

- Get a face photo database: We need a collection of faces that contain different types of faces. In this post, we used about 10 images from folders 1 and 2.
- Align and resize images: Next we need to align and enlarge images so that the center of the eye is aligned with all images. This can be done by first detecting facial landmarks. In

this post, we used the corresponding images provided in the folders. At this point, all images in the database must be the same size.

- Create a data matrix: Create a data matrix containing all images as a line vector. If all the images in the database are 100 x 100 in size and there are 20 images, we will have a matrix data size 30k x 20.
- Calculate Mean Vector [Optional]: Before performing PCA on data, we need to extract the mean vector. In our case, the vector used will be a 30k x 1 vector calculated by measuring all the matrix lines of the data. The reason for calculating this vector means that it is not necessary to use the OpenCV PCA section is because OpenCV calculates exactly what is said to us if the vector is not provided. This may not be the case for some specific algebra packages.
- Calculate Principal Components: The main components of this data matrix are calculated by finding the Eigenvectors of the covariance matrix. Fortunately, the PCA section on OpenCV handles this calculation. We just need to bring in a data matrix, and then come out a matrix containing Eigenvectors.
- Reshape Eigenvectors to obtain Eigenfaces: Eigenvectors obtained thus will be 30k in length if our data contains images of 100 x 100 x 3. We can reshape these Eigenvectors into images to obtain Eigenfaces.
